## Who is Eligible?

The computer-based examinations are available to active duty military servicemembers and eligible civilian employees with a U.S. military ID card. Other examinees who have a U.S. military ID card may take the exams on a space-available basis. Ask your local test administrator for details.

## How to Apply

1. Schedule a testing time with the local NTC test administrator. Location details can be found at [www.ed.umuc.edu/ntc](http://www.ed.umuc.edu/ntc).
2. Go to your local NTC and apply online for your chosen test. (This must be done before your scheduled exam, either days in advance or up to one hour before your exam.)
3. Complete your test within the specified time limit.
4. Receive your results the same day.
